RENO COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT LIMITS SEASONAL FLU VACCINE TO HIGH-RISK INDIVIDUALS.

Effective Monday, Reno County Health Department will target their current supply of seasonal vaccine for high-risk priority groups. Those who already have appointments for a flu shot at the Health Department will be able to get their seasonal flu vaccine.

High Risk priority groups for seasonal flu vaccine include:

- ◆ People 65 years and older
- ◆ People aged 2-64 years with heart disease, asthma, diabetes, kidney disorders, blood disorders, weakened immune systems or conditions that can weaken the respiratory system (including spinal cord injuries or neuromuscular diseases)
- ◆ Children 6-23 months of age
- ◆ Pregnant women
- ◆ Healthcare personnel who provide direct patient care
- ◆ Household contacts and out-of-home care givers of children less than 6 months old.

Vaccine manufacturers report more seasonal flu vaccine will arrive, but shipments have been slowed down due to production of the H1N1 vaccine. If you have insurance, you can check with your physician or other agencies in the community who are offering the flu shots.
