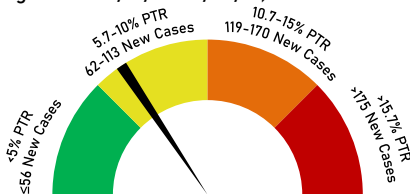

The site will allow those wanting to be tested to choose their testing site, time, and will take you through a short series of screening questions. You should be able to drive through be tested at your designated time and results will come back to you in approximately 48 hours via e-mail or text however you designate that you want to be contacted. Testing is a saliva test and you don't have to have an appointment to get tested, although it's not required.

STATE OF KANSAS UPDATES

3/4/2021: One-Hundred and four (104) counties, as well as all Native American tribes in Kansas, have a valid state of local disaster declarations on file. The SEOC continues to help facilitate vaccine distribution, scheduled for today of this week. SEOC staff monitored fires that broke out in the state today. The Kansas National Guard (KSNG) has deployed two medic teams to assist with the second booster vaccinations for schools, and an additional 7 teams have deployed to several locations to assist with community vaccinations. Four (4) teams will be assisting over the weekend. Logistics fulfilled stakeholder requests.
