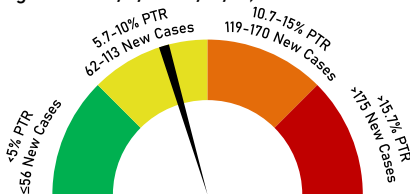

The site will allow those wanting to be tested to choose their testing site, time, and will take you through a short series of screening questions. You should be able to drive through be tested at your designated time and results will come back to you in approximately 48 hours via e-mail or text however you designate that you want to be contacted. Testing is a saliva test and you don't have to have an appointment to get tested, although it's not required.

STATE OF KANSAS UPDATES

3/1/2021: One-Hundred and four (104) counties, as well as all Native American tribes in Kansas, have a valid state of local disaster declarations on file. SEOC staff continued vaccine distribution planning, scheduled for Tuesday and Wednesday of this week. Governor Kelly is encouraging Kansans to apply for the Low Income Energy Assistance Program Funding available to help pay high electricity bills brought about by the extremely cold weather a few weeks ago. Logistics fulfilled stakeholder requests.
