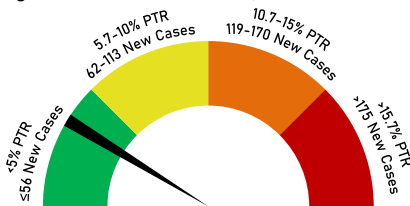

The site will allow those wanting to be tested to choose their testing site, time, and will take you through a short series of screening questions. You should be able to drive through be tested at your designated time and results will come back to you in approximately 48 hours via e-mail or text however you designate that you want to be contacted. Testing is a saliva test and you don't have to have an appointment to get tested, although it's not required.

STATE OF KANSAS UPDATES

3/17/2021: One-hundred and four (104) counties, as well as all Native American tribes in Kansas, have a valid state of local disaster declarations on file. The SEOC monitored winter weather in the southwest portion of the state with the National Weather Service issuing a Blizzard Warning for the region. The SEOC also continues to monitor flood conditions with new flood concerns expected after the spring storms move through the state tonight and tomorrow, particularly in the eastern half of Kansas.

Vaccine teams will continue to work across the state with the SEOC facilitating 22 contract nurses for vaccine support in Shawnee County. Logistics continues to fulfill stakeholder requests.
