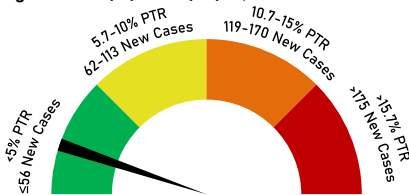

The site will allow those wanting to be tested to choose their testing site, time, and will take you through a short series of screening questions. You should be able to drive through be tested at your designated time and results will come back to you in approximately 48 hours via e-mail or text however you designate that you want to be contacted. Testing is a saliva test and you don't have to have an appointment to get tested, although it's not required.

Emergency Management Reminders:

- The state disaster declaration is extended until May 28, 2021

STATE OF KANSAS UPDATES

4/6/2021: One-Hundred and four (104) counties, as well as all Native American tribes in Kansas, have a valid state of local disaster declarations on file. This week will be heavy on the logistics section, as the SEOC is pushing out supplies to LTC's and other facilities. Staff also continue to receive the normal resource requests. National Guard teams continue to support vaccination clinics. There was a vaccine delivery today by KDEM Regional Coordinators in NE KS. Tomorrow there will be another vaccine delivery via FedEx. The state also supported a mobile test site.
