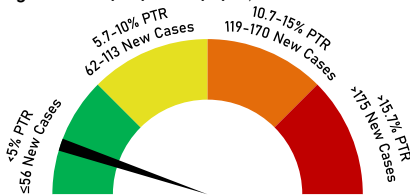

The site will allow those wanting to be tested to choose their testing site, time, and will take you through a short series of screening questions. You should be able to drive through be tested at your designated time and results will come back to you in approximately 48 hours via e-mail or text however you designate that you want to be contacted. Testing is a saliva test and you don't have to have an appointment to get tested, although it's not required.

Emergency Management Reminders:

- Reno County Commissioner declared a public health emergency on March 19, 2020 and extended this disaster declaration to June 30, 2021
- The state disaster declaration is extended until May 28, 2021

STATE OF KANSAS UPDATES

4/13/2021: One-Hundred and four (104) counties, as well as all Native American tribes in Kansas, have a valid state of local disaster declarations on file. KDHE suspended usage of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine until further investigation can be complete by the CDC and FDA due to clotting issues. Vaccine distributions continue throughout the state with assistance from the Kansas National Guard (KSNG) and contract nursing staff. Logistics continues to fulfill stakeholders' requests including syringes and needles.
