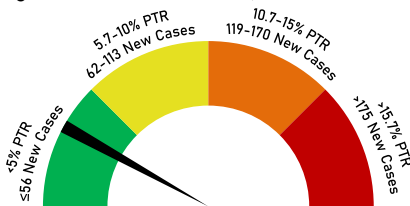

For testing site please go online at [www.gogettested.com](http://www.gogettested.com). The site will allow those wanting to be tested to choose their testing site, time, and will take you through a short series of screening questions. You should be able to drive through be tested at your designated time and results will come back to you in approximately 48 hours via e-mail or text however you designate that you want to be contacted. Testing is a saliva test and you don't have to have an appointment to get tested, although it's not required.

Emergency Management Reminders:

- Reno County Commissioner declared a public health emergency on March 19, 2020 and extended this disaster declaration to June 30, 2021
- The state disaster declaration is extended until May 28, 2021

# STATE OF KANSAS UPDATES

6/8/2021: One-Hundred (100) counties, as well as all Native American tribes in Kansas, have a valid state of local disaster declaration on file. In preparation for the state declaration expiring on June 15, 2021, SEOC Staff have begun planning for the closure of the non-congregate shelters within the state. Four (4) shelters are currently open. The last day for courier service is at 1700 on Friday, June 11th.

The KSNG and contract nursing staff continue administering vaccines at locations that have requested their assistance. Logistics fulfilled stakeholder requests to include: test kits, nitrile gloves and supplies.
