HOW CAN I CONVENE A LOCAL RESIDENT MEETING

A task force of representatives from organizations serving Reno County, along with elected leaders and public officials, have formulated a bold plan of conducting **60 community listening sessions** during **August and September** throughout Hutchinson and Reno County to find out how residents would prioritize spending of \$17-plus million earmarked for Reno County and the City of Hutchinson from the American Rescue Plan Act. Community members are invited to convene a meeting of eight to 20 Reno County residents who will offer their ideas on how our local governments should spend ARPA money.

Details:

- Meetings will be facilitated 90-minute discussions, held in person or virtually via Zoom.
- Each meeting will be assigned a facilitator so as a convener, all you need to do is invite a group of friends, peers, colleagues or community partners who are residents of Reno County to the time, date and place of your choosing, and the task force will arrange a facilitator and meeting presentation.
