<u>Commercial Vehicle Registration</u> <u>Guidelines for Counties</u>

When a customer comes in to title and/or register a truck or trailer, the **<u>FIRST</u>** question you should ask is:

"Is this vehicle going to be used as a commercial vehicle?"

"Is this Vehicle used as a Farm Vehicle?" If they answer is "yes", the vehicle is not classified as a Commercial Vehicle and <u>should be</u> registered in Movers.

What is a Commercial Vehicle?

Any vehicle that is driven or towed in the *furtherance of commerce* and is used to transport property or passengers when the vehicle:

- 1. Has a gross vehicle weight or gross combined vehicle weight of 10,001 pounds or more.
- 2. Is used to transport 15 or more passengers, including the driver.

3. Is used to transport hazardous materials in a quantity that requires having a placard in the vehicle

What is Furtherance of Commerce?

- 1. Money earned is declared as income from a business for tax purposes.
- 2. Costs for the activities are deducted as a business expense for tax purposes.
- 3. Money and/or products are accepted for advertising a sponsor on the vehicle.
- 4. The transport vehicle is being used in the furtherance of a commercial operation.
