ORDER OF INTENSIVE SUPERVISION PROBATION

NOW, on this _____ day of _____, _____, the respondent, has been placed under the supervision of Reno County Community Corrections for a period of _____ months. It is the order of the Court that the respondent shall comply with the following conditions of intensive probation:

THE RESPONDENT SHALL:

- _____ 1. Report as directed, remaining at the location specified until dismissed by the officer. Allow Community Corrections personnel to visit the reported residence, place of employment, or any other location as deemed appropriate by appointment or without prior notice. Meet all reasonable and lawful requests of the Court and supervising officer.
- _____ 2. Obey all federal and state laws, municipal and county ordinances. Notify the supervising officer of any law enforcement contact within 48 hours.
- _____ 3. Be truthful with the Intensive Supervision Officer in all matters. Do not use any other name for identification purposes other than that which is listed above.
- _____ 4. Reside at the reported place of residence and with those individuals approved by the supervising officer. Advise the supervising officer of any new residents and not change residence without prior permission from the ISO.
- _____ 5. Pay all costs as ordered by the Court according to a monthly payment schedule determined by the supervising officer. This includes a \$200.00 dollar Community Corrections administrative fee 12 substance abuse tests. Community Corrections fees shall be due by the 10th of each month with a minimum payment of \$20.00 in money order form.
- _____ 6. Regularly attend an approved educational program as determined by the ISO. Maintain passing grades and refrain from any unexcused absences. Obey the requests of school officials. Report any changes in school status to the ISO within 24 hours of such change. If not attending school (or as directed by the ISO), secure and maintain reasonable steady employment as defined by the ISO. Do not change employment unless given prior permission by your ISO.
- _____ 7. Remain within the specified county of residence unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, or if prior permission has been granted by the ISO. Obtain written permission prior to traveling outside the state of Kansas. Unnecessary travel may be restricted if not current on payment of fees.
- _____ 8. Not associate with persons or places of harmful or disreputable character (including those under the influence of or using intoxicating substances) and obtain permission from the Intensive Supervision Officer to have association with anyone who is or has been under the direct supervision of probation and/or parole.
- _____ 9. Not engage in assaultive activities, violence, or threats of violence of any kind. Do not engage in disruptive, loud, obscene, or abusive behavior while on Community Corrections property or towards Community Corrections staff.
- _____ 10. Obtain permission from the supervising officer prior to buying on credit, opening or using a checking account, and or purchasing a motor vehicle.

- _____ 11. Comply with the curfew assigned by the supervising officer.
- _____ 12. Not illegally possess, use, or traffic in any controlled substances, narcotics or any other drugs as defined by law except as prescribed by a licensed medical practitioner. Agree and consent to a blood, breath, or urine tests at the direction of the Intensive Supervision Officer. At no time make any attempt to alter said test. Cost of **additional** drug testing is the defendant's responsibility. At no time use or possess alcohol, malt beverages or any intoxicating liquid, including products containing alcohol or intoxicating substances (ie: cough medications or huffing agents). Agree not to enter any liquor store, tavern or bar nor attend any gathering or be in any location where alcoholic beverages are consumed or served.
- _____ 13. At no time possess, purchase, receive, sell or transport any firearm, ammunition, or explosive devices or any dangerous weapon as defined by the federal, state or municipal laws or ordinances.
- _____ 14. Enter and successfully complete 20 hours of Community Service Work, as directed by the Intensive Supervision Officer. Additional hours may be required if violations of supervision occur.
- _____ 15. Agree to enter into evaluation, counseling, or treatment as directed by the Intensive Supervision Officer. Comply with all recommendations as clinically indicated. Costs and arrangements for payments are the defendant's responsibility.
- _____ 16. Agree to submit to a search of my person, residence, vehicle, and effects at any time, with or without a search warrant, by any probation or law enforcement officer, when such officer has reasonable suspicion to believe that I have violated or I am in violation of the terms of my probation.
- _____ 17. Submit to DNA specimen sampling as required by law. Pay for any associated costs of such sampling.
- _____ 18. Not own, possess, or have in my possession a pager or cellular telephone unless prior permission is received from the supervising ISO.

ACCEPTANCE

I, _____, have read, or have read to me, understand and hereby accept the terms of the foregoing intensive supervision probation and hereby declare to the Court that I will do my utmost to live up to the terms thereof. I understand that the Court may at any time revoke intensive supervision probation for just cause, modify, reduce, or extend the period of probation as provided by law. I also understand that I am subject to arrest by competent authority without a warrant, but I understand that if I fulfill all the conditions of this intensive supervision probation, I will be discharged from the sentence that has been imposed against me, without further order of the Court. I do hereby agree to waive extradition to the state of Kansas from any other state of the United States, and also agree that I will not contest any effort by any state to return me to the state of Kansas.

As a parent and/or legal guardian, I understand I must report any violations to the Intensive Supervision Officer. If I fail to do this, I understand I may be held in contempt of court.
