- Unless you pay or appeal, you must fill out this form and send it or bring it to the small claims court address shown above within 30 days of the time you received it. 2.
- If you file an appeal, you do not need to fill out the form unless you lose your appeal. Then you will have 30 days to pay or complete this form and deliver it to the 3. judgment creditor.
