Reno County Public Transportation change in compressed service schedule due to COVID19.

Barbara Lilyhorn, Reno County Public Transportation Director has announced that effective at 7 a.m. on May 18, Rcat Fixed Routes will operate from 7 a.m. -6 p.m. Monday through Friday and from 9 a.m. -2 p.m. on Saturdays.

Rcat will operate <u>four</u> routes on the following schedule: 1 North hourly, 1 South hourly, 2 East will operate at 7a.m., 9 a.m., 11a.m., 1 p.m., 3 p.m., 5 p.m., 2 Northwest will operate at 8 am., 10 a.m., Noon, 2 p.m. 4 p.m. Route 3 will operate hourly.

Paratransit will operate from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. Monday through Friday and 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. on Saturday.

County On Demand will operate from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

All vehicles will observe social distancing for seating passengers and perform additional disinfection and cleaning practices.

Passengers are asked to observe good hygiene with frequent handwashing and responsible respiratory etiquette such as coughing and sneezing into their elbow bend and limiting physical contact with drivers and other passengers.

Rcat is first come first served general public transportation funded in part by KDOT.
